

**AMMENDED NOMINATION POLICY FOR MEDICAL AND  
ENGINEERING RESERVED SEATS FOR GILGIT-BALTISTAN**

**1- Short title and commencement:-**

- i. This policy shall be called Gilgit-Baltistan “**Nomination Policy for Medical and Engineering reserved seats for Gilgit-Baltistan**”.
- ii. This policy shall come into force at once.
- iii. All the nominations against **Medical** and **B.Sc. Engineering** seats shall be made by the Gilgit-Baltistan Nomination Board under this policy.

**2- Composition of Nomination Board**

Gilgit-Baltistan Nomination Board will comprise of the following:-

**3- Jurisdiction of Nomination Board**

- a. Nomination against **MBBS, BDS** and **B.Sc. Engineering** reserved seats shall be made by the Nomination Board.
- b. Nominations other than **MBBS/BDS** and **B.Sc. Engineering** reserved seats for GB in various disciplines shall be made by the Director Education Colleges GB (Secretary Nomination Board) according to admission criteria as laid down in prospectus of respective institutions on the basis of merit at GB level and district level.

## Part -A

### **4. GENERAL RULES FOR NOMINATION AGAINST MBBS AND BDS RESERVED SEATS FOR GILGIT-BALTISTAN**

#### **4.0 General Eligibility of candidates for MBBS and BDS reserved seats for Gilgit- Baltistan**

4.1 The basic eligibility for admission in 1<sup>st</sup> year **MBBS/BDS** course of respective provinces/Medical Colleges as laid down in their prospectus shall be followed.

4.2 Candidates who have passed **F.Sc.** with **660/1100 (60%)** marks (pre-Med.) or equivalent from any recognized Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education ,provided that the candidate possesses Gilgit-Baltistan domicile.

4.3 Candidates, who have passed an examination of foreign university/Board shall have to submit equivalence certificates issued by Inter Board Committee of Chairmen, Islamabad.

4.4 Candidates appeared in the single medical entry test from **Punjab** province shall only be eligible to apply for **MBBS/BDS** seats in medical Colleges of Punjab.

4.5 Candidates appeared in medical entry test from **Khyber Pukhtunkhwa** province shall only be eligible to apply for **MBBS/BDS** seats in the medical colleges of the province.

4.6 Candidates fulfilling criteria/appeared in the entry tests of Province of **Sindh** shall only be eligible to apply for **MBBS/BDS** seats in the medical Colleges of Sindh province if test conducted in future.

4.7 Candidates fulfilling criteria/appeared in entry test of province of **Baluchistan** shall only be eligible to apply for **MBBS/BDS** seats in the medical Colleges of **Baluchistan** .

- 4.8 In case of no candidate fulfils criteria of Sindh and AJ&K the nomination against reserved seats in Sindh and AJ & K, shall be made on the basis of highest aggregate score of Punjab or KPK, whichever is higher. Seats will not be allotted on the basis of mean aggregate score of two provinces.
- 4.9 As the medical colleges of AJ&K and Sindh accept/consider the entry test results of Punjab or KPK. Nominations against medical seats of AJ&K and Sindh will be made on the basis of highest aggregate score of Punjab or KPK till there is no change in admission criteria of medical colleges of Sindh and AJ& K.

## 5. **Preparation of Merit List**

- 5.1 Merit list against MBBS/BDS reserved seats shall be prepared on the basis of weightage formula determined by respective provinces, which change from time to time.

### 5.2 **Existing weightage criteria:-**

### 5.3 **Passing criteria of entry tests of KPK and Punjab**

At present there is no pass marks limit in the entry tests of Punjab, KPK , Baluchistan, conducted for admission in their respective medical colleges . However, in future the criteria of nomination in medical colleges of Punjab, KPK and Baluchistan shall be made, keeping in view eligibility of respective provinces, whenever there is change in criteria of passing marks in entry tests.

- 5.4 Separate merit lists of all **provinces and A J & K** shall be prepared keeping in view the weightage formula of each province/state as mentioned at **Section (5.2) of part-A** Suppra. Any subsequent change/amendment in admission policy/rules made by provinces/AJ&K, universities/colleges, the new admission rules/policy of respective provinces/AJ&K, universities/colleges shall be applicable.
- 5.5 10 marks from F.Sc. or equivalent shall be deducted in case of improvement in F.Sc. or equivalent for the purpose of nomination.

- 5.6 10 marks shall be deducted from F.Sc or equivalent, in case of any gap in the year of nomination and 5 marks shall be deducted, for gap of each year, from the second year.
- 5.7 20 marks will be awarded in case of Hafiz Quran, Provided that he/she qualifies the test/assessment conducted by the Nomination Board.

## **6. Surety Bond/Under Taking**

- 6.1 A surety Bond/Under Taking worth amounting **Rs. 1.00 million** (ten Lac) with two sureties in the like amount, shall be obtained from the selected male and female students against **MBBS/BDS** reserved seats for Gilgit Baltistan to the effect that after completion of their studies they shall serve in Gilgit Baltistan at least for 05 years other wise the defaulter shall pay back **Rs. 1.00 million** (ten Lac) to the Government.
- 6.2 The doctors shall report to the Health Department within two months, after completion of their course and ensure their availability to serve in Gilgit-Baltistan. If the Govt. does not provide employment opportunity within one year failing which Health Department GB will issue NOC to the doctors to serve anywhere.
- 6.3 After graduation, if the doctors, without reporting to Health Department GB, will get admission in any specialized course or go abroad, they will deposit 1.00 million in govt. treasury.

## **7 Distribution/Allotment Of Medical Reserved Seats**

- 7.1 50 % Seats shall be allocated to districts in proportion to their respective population and 50 % seats shall be on open merit at Gilgit-Baltistan level. Selection against open merit as well as district quota seats shall be made on highest aggregate score of any province. Criteria of respective province shall also be observed during selection of students against medical reserved seats. The district quota seats will also be allotted to highest merit candidate either on the basis of aggregate score of Punjab, KPK or any other province, if medical seat is available in the same province. In case a student has high merit in Punjab and the seat is available in KPK province and another student of same district who has obtained high

marks in the KPK, the candidate having high marks in KPK will be allotted district seat in KPK on the basis of aggregate score of KPK Province. Usually the Bolan Medical College , Quetta Baluchistan conducts its own pre-admission test in the month of December each year, in such a case, the medical reserved seat of BMC Quetta will be left on open merit.

- 7.2 The reserved 05 BDS seats shall be distributed 100% on open merit. However, these seats will be distributed in accordance with the provision of **Section 7(7.1) Part-A** above.
- 7.3 Candidates shall be asked to indicate their choices/priorities of courses as well as institutions on prescribed Nomination forms and choices of students will be preferred during selection. However in case, if any student has not opted any medical college and he/she is on merit, the Nomination Board Gilgit-Baltistan shall select/nominate the students in any medical college of the country where the candidate is fulfilling eligibility criteria.
- 7.4 If a district quota seat falls vacant after selection, the next highest merit candidate of the same district shall be selected for nomination.
- 7.5 In case of equal merit, higher marks in F.Sc. or equivalent shall be given preference.
- 7.6 In case of both equal marks in F.Sc./ET (merit) higher marks in SSC shall be given preference.
- 7.7 If Gilgit-Baltistan open merit seat falls vacant after selection/nomination, the next highest merit candidate, immediate after open merit seats, shall be treated as open merit seat. However, Institutions will be allotted or reallocated on the basis of highest aggregate score.
- 7.8 In case of increase or decrease in the number of reserved seats the Nomination Board will distribute the seats as per policy given in **Para-7.1** above.
- 7.9 in all such cases where rules/policy is silent, the decision of Nomination Board shall be final.
8. Recently 03 new districts have been established in Gilgit-Baltistan. MBBS seats of district share shall be distributed among all districts of Gilgit-Baltistan on the basis of population of respective districts. These seats will

be distributed according to 1998 census until new census in the region is not conducted.

## **Part-B**

## **ELIGIBILITY OF CANDIDATES FOR B.Sc ENGINEERING SEATS**

- 4.0 A candidate shall be eligible for nomination against **B.Sc. engineering** reserved seats if:-
- 4.1 The basic eligibility for admission in 1st year B.Sc Engineering course of respective provinces / colleges as laid down in their prospectus shall be followed.
- i. The candidates, who have passed F.Sc (pre-engineering) or equivalent from any recognized Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education with 60% marks.
  - ii. Candidate possesses Gilgit-Baltistan domicile.
  - iii. Candidate has passed prescribed entry tests of respective provinces/AJ&K.
- 4.2 Candidate, who has passed an examination of foreign university/Board, shall have to submit equivalence certificate issued by Inter Board Committee of Chairmen, Islamabad.
- 4.3 Candidates passed entry test from Punjab province shall only be eligible to apply for B.Sc. Engineering seats in Engineering Colleges/Universities of Punjab province.
- 4.4 Candidates passed entry test from **Khyber PukhtunKhwa** province shall only be eligible to apply for B.Sc. Engineering seats in the Engineering Colleges/ Universities of **Khyber PukhtunKhwa** province.
- 4.5 Candidates passed entry test from **AJ&K** shall only be eligible to apply for B.Sc. Engineering seats in the Engineering Colleges/Universities of **AJ&K**.
- 4.6 Candidates fulfilling criteria/passing marks of entry test of province of **Sindh** shall be eligible to apply for B.Sc. Engineering seats in the Engineering Colleges/Universities of **Sindh** province.
- 4.7 Candidates fulfilling criteria/ passing marks of entry test of province of **Baluchistan** shall be eligible to apply for B.Sc. Engineering seats in Engineering colleges/Universities of **Baluchistan**.
- 4.8 In case of no student appears/fails to pass entry test in any province/AJ&K, the nomination against reserved seats in that province/college will be



made on the basis of highest aggregate score from amongst other provinces/regions.

## 5 **PROVINCE/INSTITUTION WISE WEIGHTAGE FOR DETERMINATION OF MERIT**

### **FOR B.Sc ENGINEERING SEATS**

5.1 Merit list against **B.Sc\_Engineering** reserved seats shall be prepared on the basis of weightage formula determined by respective provinces and AJ&K, which change from time to time.

### **Passing criteria of entry test**

5.2 Passing criteria of entry tests of provinces/institutions shall be followed as laid down in their prospectus.

5.3 Separate merit lists of all provinces and AJ&K shall be prepared keeping in view the weightage formula of each province/AJ& K as mentioned at section (5.1) of part-B Suppra. Any subsequent change/amendment in admission policy/rules made by provinces/ AJ&K, universities/colleges, the new admission rules/policy of respective provinces, universities/colleges shall be applicable.

## 6 **PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST**

- 6.1 Separate merit lists of each province including AJ & K shall be prepared keeping in view the weightage formula of each province/institution as mentioned in **Section (5.1) Part-B** above. However, while selecting the students against **B.Sc. Engineering** reserved seats province wise merit shall be observed. In case of any change in weightage criteria by any province, the amended criteria shall be followed by the Nomination Board.
- 6.2 Separate merit list shall be prepared against self- finance B.Sc. Engg.reserved seats.
- 6.3 10 marks from F.Sc. or equivalent shall be deducted in case of improvement in F.Sc. or equivalent for the purpose of nomination.
- 6.4 10 marks shall be deducted from F.Sc or equivalent, in case of any gap in the year of nomination and 5 marks shall be deducted, for gap of each year, from the second year.
- 6.5 20 marks shall be awarded in case of Hafiz Quran, provided that he/she qualifies the test/assessment conducted by Nomination Board.

## 7 **Distribution/ allotment. of B.Sc Engineering seats**

**50%** seats shall be allocated to districts on population basis and **50%** seats shall be allocated on open merit at GB level. Selection against open merit as well as district quota seats shall be made on highest aggregate score of any province. Criteria of respective province shall also be observed during selection of students against Engineering reserved seats. The district quota seats will be allotted to highest merit candidate either on the basis of aggregate score of Punjab, KPK or any other province, if seat is available in the same province.

Candidates shall be asked to indicate their choices/priorities of courses as well as institutions on prescribed Nomination forms and choices of students will be referred during selection and choice of technology will be given higher precedence on choice of institution. However in case, if any student has not opted any Technology and he/she is on merit, the Nomination Board Gilgit-Baltistan shall select/nominate the students in any institution of the country where the candidate is fulfilling eligibility criteria.

Self-finance **B.Sc. Engineering** reserved seats shall be allotted on open merit basis who applied for the seats.

- 7.4 In case of equal merit, higher marks in F.Sc. shall be given preference.

- 7.5 In case of both equal marks in F.Sc./ET (merit) higher marks in SSC shall be given preference.
- 7.6 If a seat of district allocated on the basis of population falls vacant after selection, the next on merit candidate of the same district shall be selected for nomination.
- 7.7 In case of increase or decrease in the number of reserved seats the Nomination Board will distribute the seats as per policy given in Para-7.1 above.
- 8.** Recently 03 new districts have been established in Gilgit-Baltistan and 17 new Engineering seats have been enhanced by the Punjab Government from the current academic session. Out of total 71 reserved seats 50% seats will be distributed among districts on population basis and 50% will be on open merit at GB level.

**10                            General rules applicable for medical and B.Sc. engineering seats.**

- 10.1 Nominations/Selection shall be made on the basis of personal or parental domicile issued by District Magistrate; Provisional domicile shall not be accepted.

- 10.2 Students shall submit an undertaking on non-Judicial stamp paper to the effect that all the documents are correct not tempered and they shall abide by all the rules of nomination.
- 10.3 Students shall not be selected /nominated on the basis of mother/Maternal domicile except in case of demise of father, mother's domicile shall be considered.
- 10.4 In case of concealing facts, submitting fake documents, the candidate shall be debarred from nomination process and a fine of **Rs. 200,000** (Two Lac) shall be imposed.
- 10.5 Prescribed application forms shall be provided against postal order/bank draft @ **Rs. 300/-**
- 10.6 Funds collected out of nomination forms/policy will be utilized for printing of nomination forms/policy, stationery, Board meetings, repairing of machinery equipments, law charges, Telephone and DSL charges and other miscellaneous expenditure.
- 10.7 Last dates for submission of application forms fixed by the department shall be treated final and no application form for nomination shall be received /entertained after due date.
- 10.8 Applications of the candidates whose results (HSSC and entry test) are not declared till the last date of submission of application forms for nomination shall not be considered.
- 10.9 Incomplete application forms shall not be considered /entertained.
- 10.10 Selected students shall show and provide original documents before Issuance of nomination letters.
- 10.11 Nomination Board's decisions on 2/3 majority shall be final in case of any decision made on voting.
- 10.12 Students shall submit written refusals on non judicial stamp paper duly attested by Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> class within **10 days** after issuance of nomination letters, if any nominee does not want to avail the seat.
- 10.13 GB Nomination Board shall hold two meetings for selection against **MBBS, BDS** and **B.Sc. Engineering** seats. In first meeting the Board shall make provisional selection against medical and B.Sc. Engineering reserved seats.
- 10.14 The provisional selection list shall be displayed for at least five **05 days** for information of the students. Objections/appeals against provisional selection shall be finalized in the second meeting of Nomination Board.

- 10.15 In absence of chairman Nomination Board, Secretary Education Gilgit Baltistan shall chair the meeting.
- 10.16 In any nominee, who will not join the college/Institution within prescribed time(fixed by the Institution or province). His/her nomination shall stand cancelled automatically and next on merit candidate shall be nominated.
- 10.17 Students who will not submit all the required documents within prescribed time by the Secretary Nomination Board, shall not be entertained in belated stage.
- 10.18 In case a candidate has already been nominated, in any professional course and he/she has already got admission in the course. He/she shall not be considered for nomination against the MBBS & B.Sc Engineering seats.
